Do you have old electronics? Used motor oil in your home? Old cans of paint? Used batteries?

As part of the residential solid waste contract with WM, effective January 1, 2022, you have a convenient opportunity to dispose of your household hazardous waste (HHW) - safely, easily and responsibly. Introducing the At Your Door Special Collection Program, a residential serviced offered by WM to provide year-round collections for residents in North Huntingdon Township.

To dispose of household hazardous waste and schedule a collection at your home, contact us in one of two ways:

Waste Management will offer convenient service in your community for residents to properly dispose and recycle home-generated special materials- safely, easily, and responsibly. These items may include paints, household cleaners, compact fluorescent lamps (CFL), automotive products, garden chemicals, batteries, electronics, and more. Do not place these items at the curb with regular garbage - they will not be collected. A packet will be mailed to you with specific instructions for a special pickup.

The materials accepted through this program include:

 **Automotive Products**
Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil and filters, fuels, and more.

 **Electronics**
Computers, monitors, keyboards, MP3 players, televisions (limit one per call), DVD/CD players, tape players, VCR, cell phones, desktop printers, fax machines, and microwaves.

 **Garden Chemicals**
Fertilizers, insect sprays, herbicides, pesticides, and weed killers.

 **Paint Products**
Paint, caulk, glue, stain, stripper, thinner, and wood preservative.

 **Household Cleaners**
Ammonia, heavy-duty cleaner, rust remover, tile/shower cleaner, upholstery cleaner, and more.

 **Mercury containing items**
Batteries, compact fluorescent lamps, fluorescent tubes, thermometers, and thermostats.

We do not collect ammunition, explosives, asbestos, tires, propane tanks or any materials in unlabeled or leaking containers. For program details, contact (800) 449-7587.

Your Township provides a comprehensive solid waste program designed to encourage recycling and waste reduction, reduce litter in our neighborhoods and ensure that waste is disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner. Waste Management (WM) looks forward to helping your community be as clean and green as possible.

General Information

Your collection day will remain the same. All items must be placed at the curb no later than 6 a.m. on your day of collection.

Despite our best efforts, we occasionally miss scheduled collections. If we do, please call us at (800) 451-3060 as soon as you can. Our representatives will work with you to ensure that your materials get picked up. You can also visit us at www.wm.com for live chat and email options

Observed Holidays

Waste Management only observes the following holidays. When your collection falls on or after one of these holidays, your service will be delayed one day during that week only. (*There will be no delay in observance of New Year's Day or Christmas Day in 2022.*)

Automated Collection

Beginning in 2022, North Huntingdon Township residents will receive automated waste and recycling collection. Automated collection is a more efficient and safer means of collection for our drivers.

Most residents will receive a 96-gallon trash cart and a 64-gallon recycling cart. Senior discount options are available, please contact Waste Management at (800) 451-3060 for more information regarding service options for senior residents.

Cart delivery will begin the week of December 6. Please do not use your cart until your first service day the week of January 3, 2022.

NEED AN ADDITIONAL CART?

Each 96-gallon cart will hold approximately eight (8) standard size kitchen trash bags. If needed, additional trash carts are available for an additional \$6 per month, per cart. Residents can receive an additional trash cart by contacting Waste Management at (800) 451-3060.

Senior Discount Options are also available. Contact Waste Management for more information.

Bulk Items and Overflow Material

Waste Management will only collect material that fits inside your trash and recycling cart. All trash must be bagged and fit inside the cart. Recyclables must be placed loose into your recycling cart and boxes must be broken down. Additional trash carts are available for an additional \$6 per month.

WM will collect one bulk item once per month at no additional charge. Place your bulk item at the curb on the same day as your trash collection during your bulk collection week. Items must be smaller than seven feet and weigh less than 50 pounds. Residents are permitted one bulk item per month at no additional charge. Additional items can be arranged for pickup for a fee by calling WM.

2022 Bulk Collection Calendar

Bulk collection will occur on your service day during the second FULL week of the month:

What is a bulk item?

A bulk item is an appliance, piece of furniture, or some other residential item that's to large for a container. Construction debris and hazardous waste are not allowed as bulk items. Waste Management asks that residents call (800) 451-3060 in advance to schedule collection of a white-goods appliance.

Bulk Waste

- Smaller than 7 feet, lighter than 50 pounds
- Couches, chairs, household furniture
- Carpeting (cut into 4-foot bundles)
- Washer, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, toilets, etc.

NOT Bulk Waste and Unaccepted Materials

- Larger than 7 feet, heavier than 50 pounds
- Concrete, brick, asphalt, roofing, electronics
- Vehicles and parts
- Building materials such as plaster, dry wall, wood, construction debris, etc.

RECYCLE RIGHT

Great things happen when North Huntingdon Township residents use Recycle Right. By recycling everyday items like those shown below, tons of raw materials, time, energy and money are saved.

- Place only the acceptable recyclables shown below in your recycling cart.
- Containers that held food should be rinsed free of food debris and liquid.
- Do not bag your recyclables - empty recyclables directly into your recycling cart.

Recyclables must be placed directly into your recycling cart. Material outside of the cart will not be collected. Residents will receive weekly recycling.
