Strategically located in Westmoreland County, PA between downtown Pittsburgh and Greensburg.

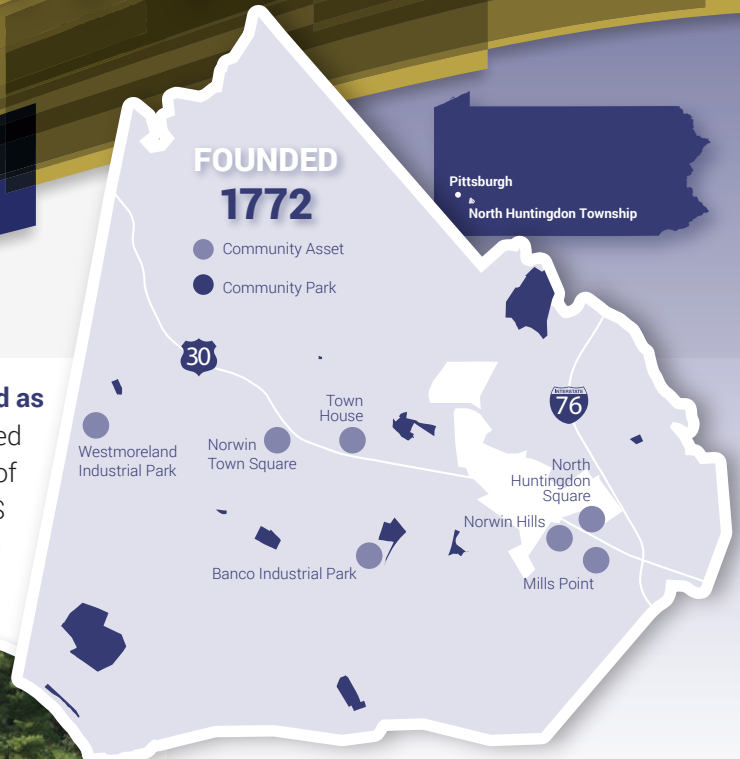
Convenient access to major highways, including US Route 30 and Interstate 76, the Pennsylvania Turnpike.
